Documents /Materials to be brought by the team manger:

- Authorization letter signed by the Head of the institution.
- Photo Identity card of the player as per the CBSE online registration (UID).
- School flag
- A signed copy of the eligibility proforma filled online.
- Group photo of the participants and team manager with the Principal duly attested by Principal.
- All teams should participate for the march past.
- Student /player studying in class IX and above have to provide copy of the CBSE registration number given by the school.
- All the supporting documents verifying the age of the player, etc. in original, as per the CBSE guideline and rules shall be carried personally by the team manager/coach while reporting for participation.
- The participating schools are requested to make their own arrangements for return journey reservation.
- The schools are requested to bring the latest photo copy of the sports affiliation fee paid to CBSE for year 2019-2020.
- All the supporting papers for age verification of the player etc. In original, as per the CBSE guideline &rules shall be carried personally by the team manager /coach while reporting for participation
- The player's right to participate forfeits if failed to produce the papers supporting the eligibility in original on demand.

GENERAL INSTRUCTIONS

- Participants are requested not to bring any valuable items such as jewellery, mobile, camera, laptop etc. The team managers will be responsible for the safety of their own belongings and the loss/ damage to the host school property.
- The participating schools are requested to submit the travel details providing, exact date, time and mode of journey to enable the organizers to pick up the teams from railway station/bus station.
- Every participant is expected to maintain proper discipline in the school campus during his/her stay.
- Any damage done to the property of the organizing school during the stay by any of the participants shall be compensated by the respective manager/coach.
- All the participating teams should pay a refundable caution deposit of Rs. 1000/- per

each age category (girls and boys) at the reporting time and it will be returned after necessary clearance by the organizing committee.

- Any violation in eligibility (over age or impersonation) shall be dealt with according to rules.
- The original eligibility proforma of athlete/players/teams qualified to participate in cluster /zone level to national level will have to be certified by the organizing school at venue, immediately after their cluster /zone level tournament is over.
- Medical checkup may also be applied by the jury of appeal appointed by the organizing school in cases of over age suspicion.
- A player shall be under 17 or 19 years of age on 31st December 2019
 - o Under 17 years :Born on or after 01-01-2003
 - o Under 19 years :Born on or after 01-01-2001
- Any team/athlete not fulfilling the eligibility criteria before the commencement of the tournament /meet shall not be permitted to participate.
- Every player / athlete / team shall carry with them required details as mentioned under the "Eligibility".
- Every team shall carry their school flag for the purpose of march-past. Participation in march- past is compulsory, failing which, the right to participate can be forfeited.
- Also, it is the responsibility of the school/team staying outside, to collect information regarding matches/ fixtures / programme. The teams are also expected to report to the ground atleast 20 min before their match.
- All the team shall be accompanied by a teacher /coach/manager designated by the participating school Principal.
- No team will be permitted to participate without being accompanied by officials.
- No team shall be accompanied by any parent. However if a parent is accompanying the team, such information may be provided by the school on the school letterhead.
- No team shall be accompanied by more than two officials.
- In case of girl's participants, one of the officials accompanying the team must be a female.
- The officials accompanying the team shall have a valid identity card issued by their school Principal.
- No extra person shall be permitted to stay inside the school premises or on the playing field along with the team.
- If a school, after filling-in its entry, wishes to withdraw from a tournament/meet, it shall give a written request of its intention to do so to the organizing secretary/ school.
- School withdrawing without informing/requesting the organizing school, will be penalized with a penalty of RS 1000.
- A player/team may be disqualified\scratched for the following reasons
 - 1. If the ineligibility of any member of the team is detected.
 - 2. Inclusion of non bonafide student in the team.
 - 3. Misbehavior on ground by athlete or accompanying officials.
 - 4. Use of abusive language by athlete or accompanying official.
 - 5. Misbehavior with officials/ opponents by athlete or accompanying officials.

- 6. Indiscipline at place of stay by the athlete or accompanying official
- 7. Damaging the school property.
- 8. Indiscipline during the opening and closing ceremonies by the athlete or accompanying officials.
- 9. Non participation in march past.
- The organizing school in no case shall show the eligibility proforma or any other paper of a team to anyone who lodges the protest. It is only the jury of appeals prerogative to verify all the documents.
- Protest of any nature in connection with the tournament shall be in writing and must reach the organizing Sectary and CBSE observer within one hour of the declaration of result, along with the protest fee of Rs. 1000/- Such protest will be considered by the Jury of Appeal, consisting of following:-
- 1. Principal, Organizing school 2. Organizing Secretary 3.CBSE Observer 4.One or two technically qualified people at the venue
- The parties under dispute may be heard before deciding the issue .In case the protest is uploaded, the protest fee shall be refunded to the respective school otherwise the fee shall be forfeited .The decision taken by the Jury of appeal will be final and binding. The decision, together with full facts of the protest may immediately be reported to the Jt. Director (sports) CBSE.
- Our entire campus is under CCTV surveillance, No type of misbehavior will be tolerated. All team members are expected to maintain discipline. In case any person is found breaking any rules strict action may be taken by the Organising committee.
- Use of intoxicants is strictly prohibited.
- Please keep in mind to use water and electricity wisely.
- Please follow the hostel rules strictly.
- All other rules will be as per CBSE guidelines.
